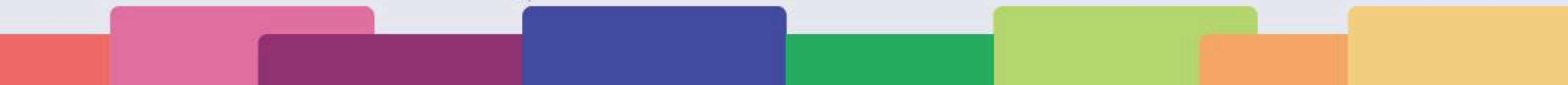

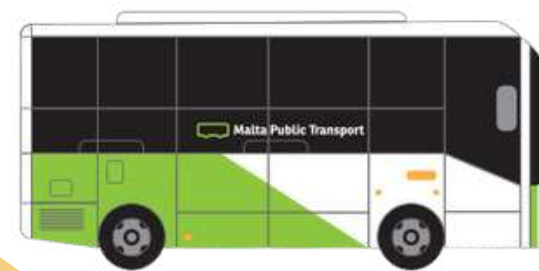


Getting a bus card

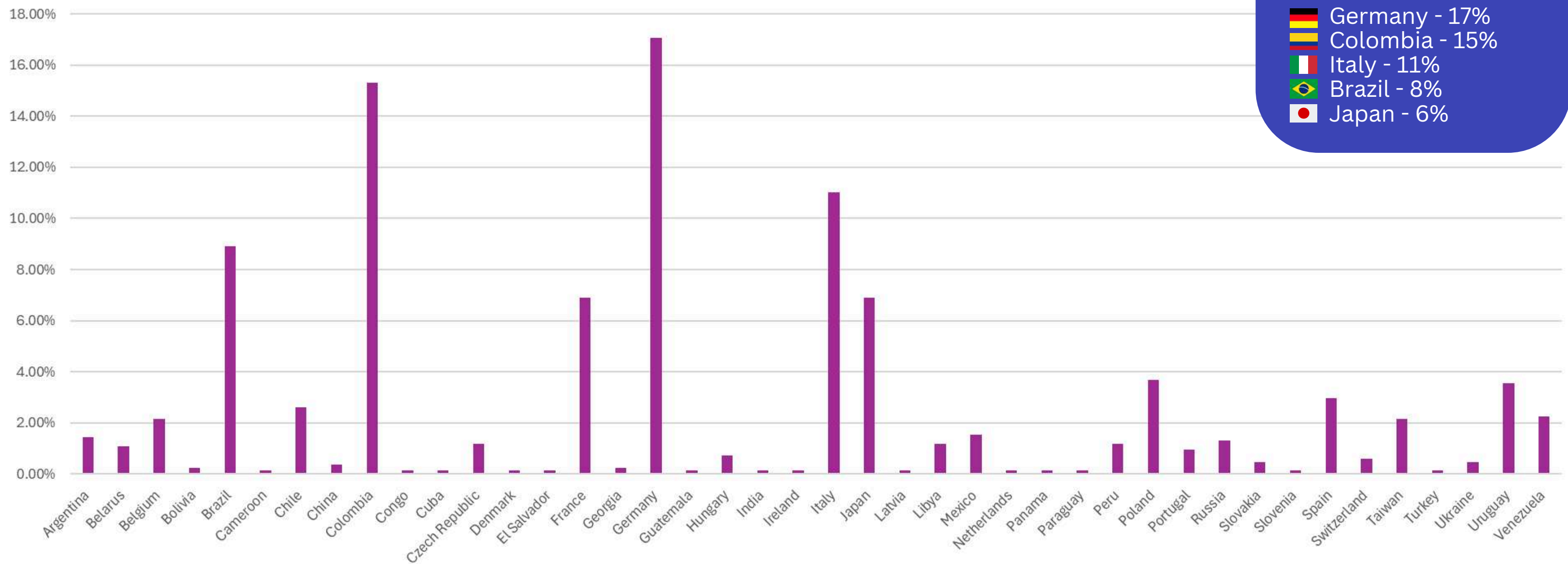


Nationality Mix - 2024

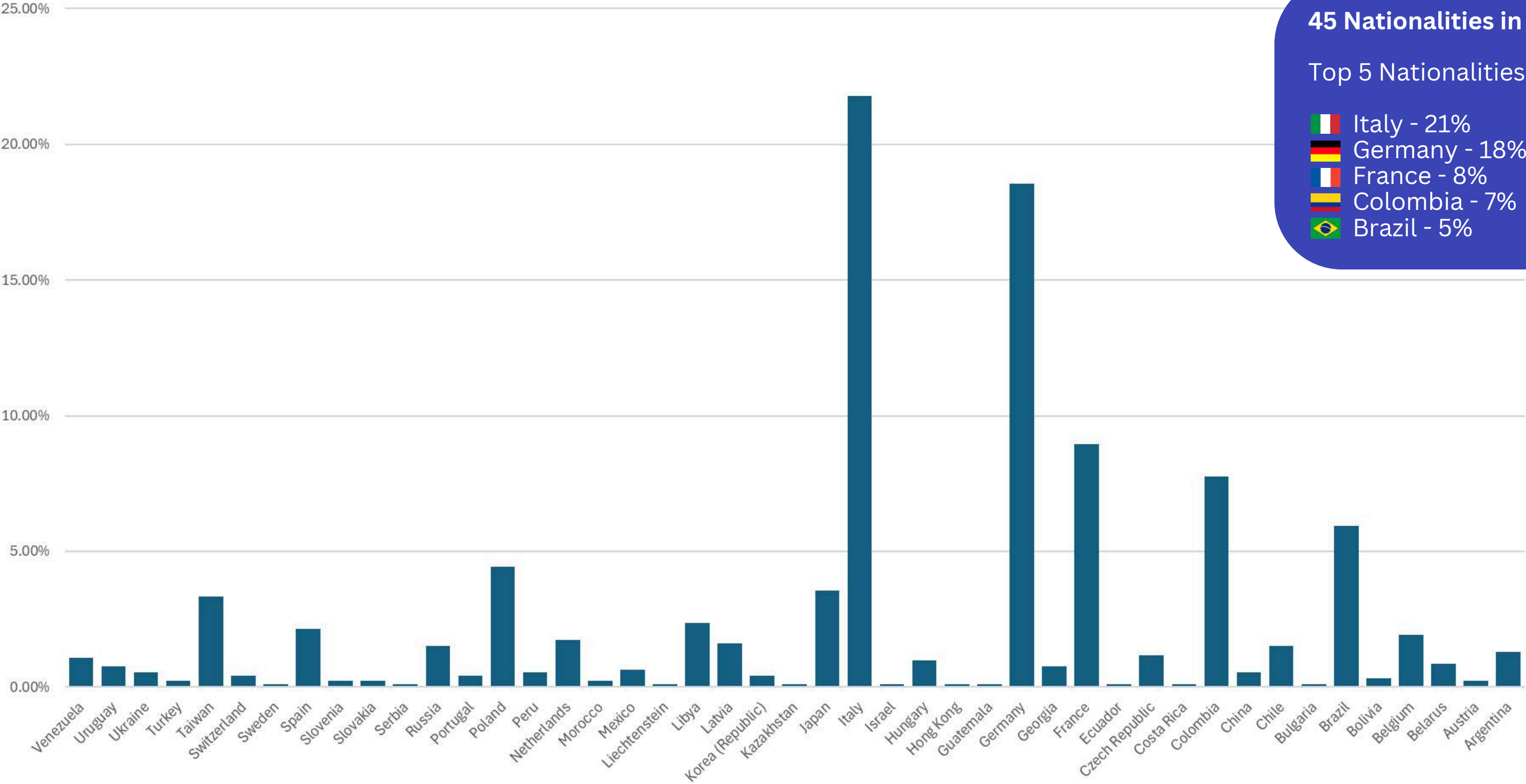


Nationality Mix - 2025

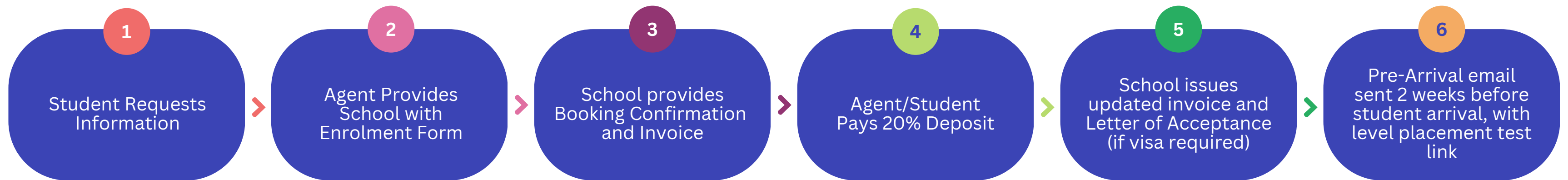

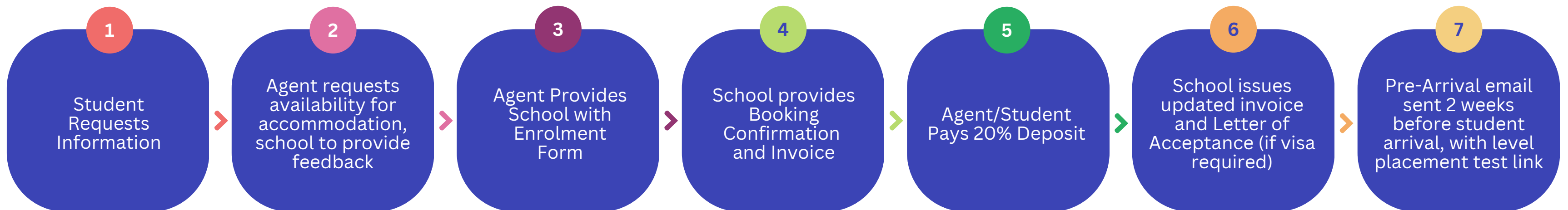

Insurance



Insurance Type: Multirisk Plus Cancellation

What's Covered:

Cancellation/ Curtailement

Up to €7,500 for cancellation of travel, tuition, excursions etc. including visa refusal

Trip Rearrangement

Up to €1,000 for students who need to change their travel dates, without needing to cancel their plans

Delayed Departure

Up to €80 for delayed departure due to industrial action, bad weather, mechanical fault, etc.

Missed Departure

Up to €7,500 for extra costs of travel/accommodation needed until next flight

Baggage Delay

Up to €100 for emergency replacement of clothing, medication and toiletries

Baggage, Personal Money and Travel Docs

Up to €2000 for accidental loss, theft or damage to baggage or documents or cash during the trip

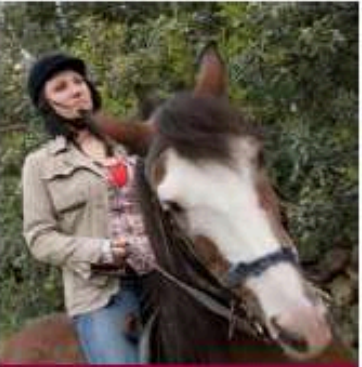

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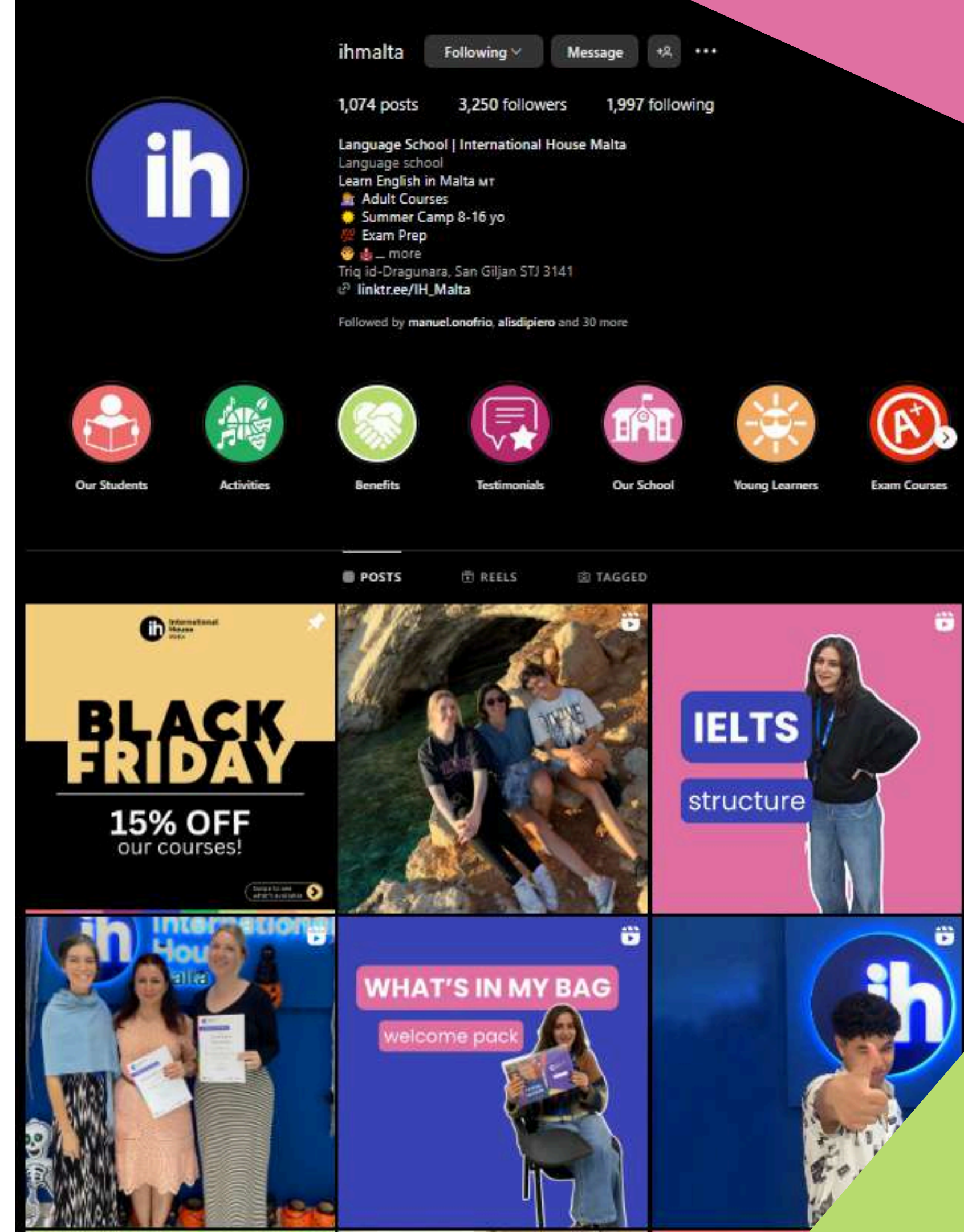
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
