Our Academic Programme

Students are divided into a class based on their English level and ages.

The online level placement test is sent 2 weeks before the student arrival along with the pre-arrival information.

Course Content:

- Cover all 4 skills when learning a language(reading, writing, speaking and listening)
- Follow a project-based learning approach, which encourages students to practice the skills they learn, as well as work on their teamwork, and creative critical thinking skills.

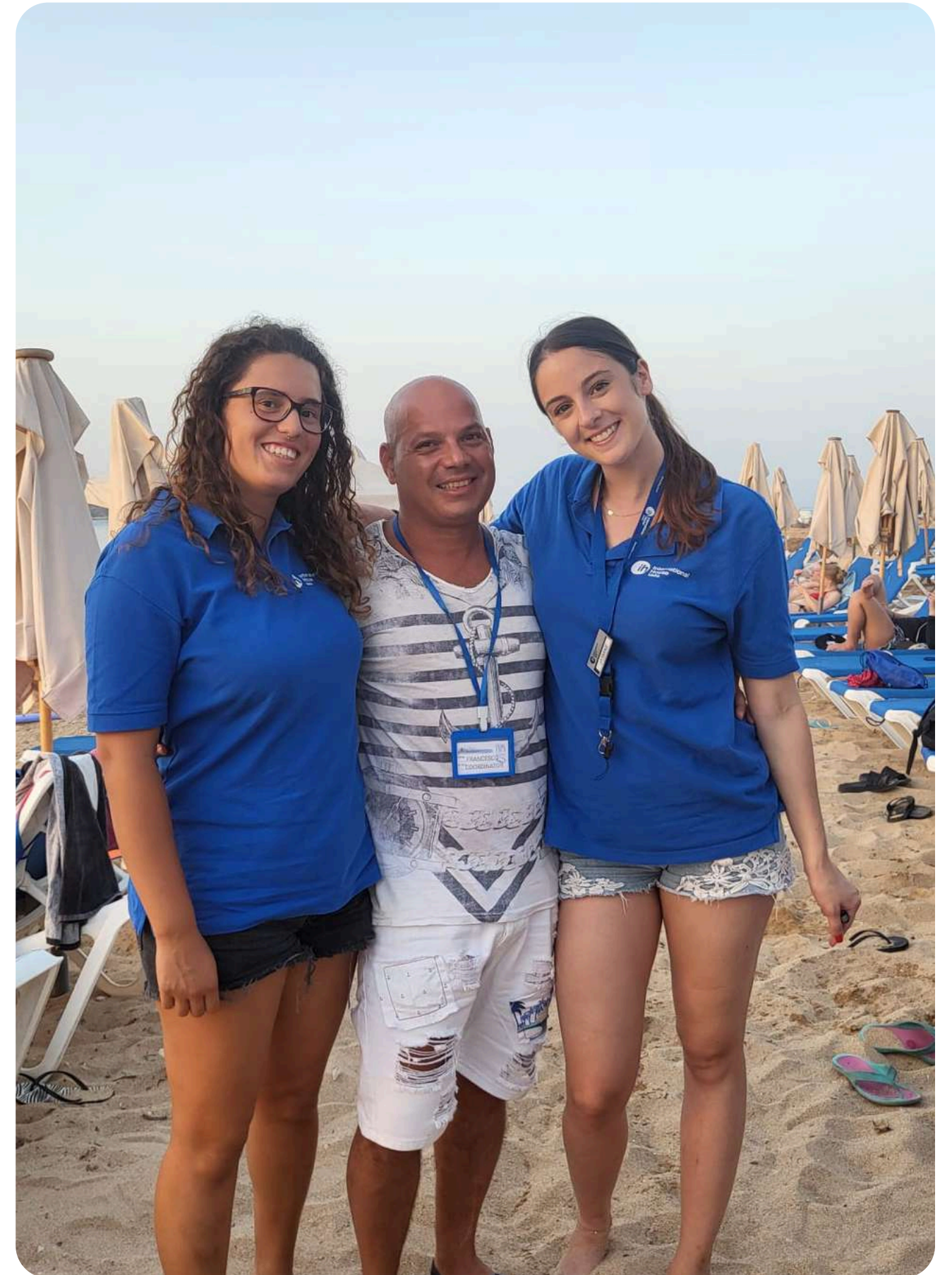
Certificate of Attendance and personalised student report is also provided



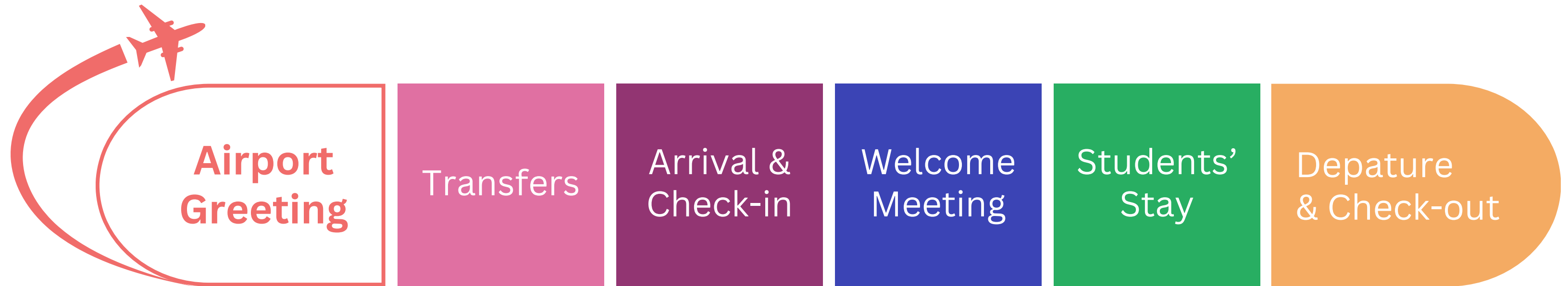
Activities

Keeping students safe

- All Staff on activities are trained to handle every situation, and student safety is of utmost importance

Student Journey

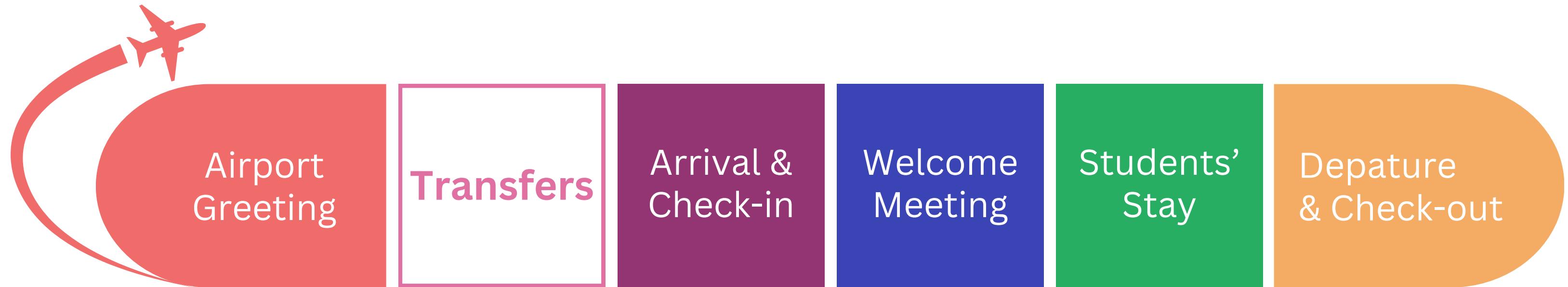


- IH Staff/ Taxi driver will meet students at the airport

- Students will be given a tour of the campus

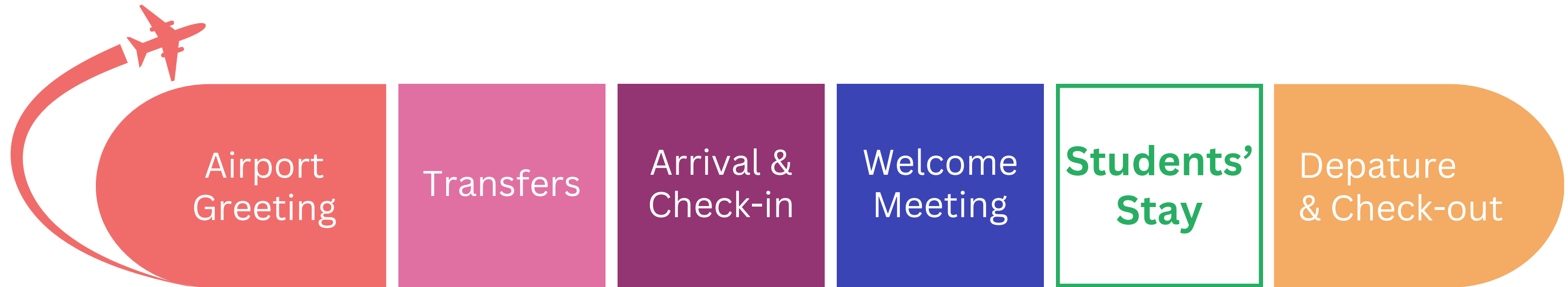
Student Journey



When a student arrives, they will:

- Be given the welcome pack
- Will be given information on campus rules and health and safety information
- Fill-in the student information sheet and have a “passport” photo taken for their student card
- Briefed on the activities of that week, and what they need to bring
- Welcome meeting is done prior to the evening activity, with other students that arrived during the day, encouraging students to get to know each other

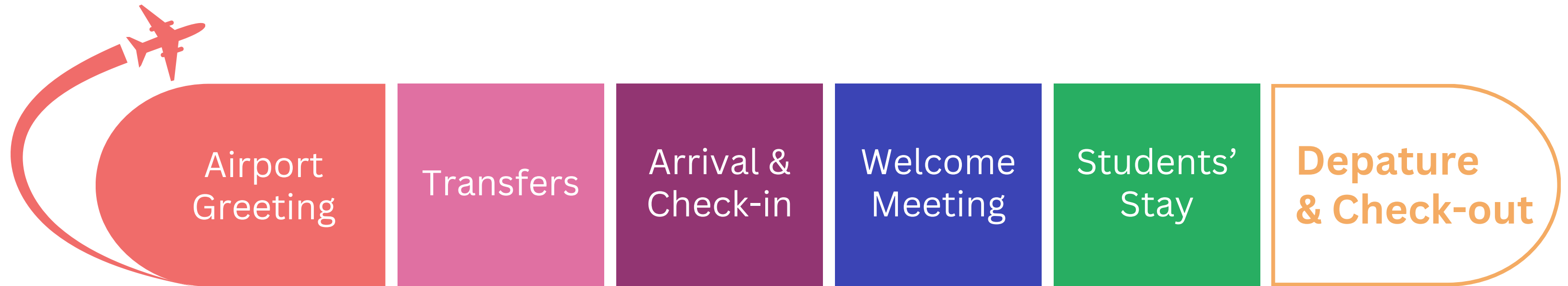
Student Journey



During the students' stay they can expect:

- English Lessons: Fun, interactive classes with small groups and qualified teachers.
- Activities: Sports, creative workshops, and cultural excursions around Malta.
- Social Interaction: Make international friends and practice English in real-life settings.
- Supervision & Safety: 24/7 staff support and secure accommodation.
- Exciting Experiences: Beach days, themed parties, and adventure activities.

Student Journey



- Campus staff will inspect the student's room, to ensure there are no breakages
- Student departure voucher, valuables (if given to us) and €50 damage deposit to be returned
- Check-out to be done by 11am on departure day
- Student can join activities/lessons if catching a later flight
- Luggage storage available in the admin office
- We offer assistance for unaccompanied minors, IH Malta Staff member to stay with students
- Campus staff to wait with student until departure transfer comes to collect the student
- Transfer driver will escort the student to the check-in desk and will guide the student to security



Student Welfare

Student Safety

- We have a zero tolerance on bullying and harassment
- All staff members on campus have safeguarding training
- Students are supervised 24/7
- Emergency numbers and staff on call are available at first response
- First aiders on site and pharmacies/health centres nearby

Student Support

- **Wake-up call** - Campus staff make sure students wake up for breakfast
- **Morning Assembly** - Students are reminded of the activity that day and what they need to bring with them
- **Birthdays** - This is a special day for students, so we take utmost care to ensure these students have an unforgettable day!
- **Open door policy** - Students know that if they have any issue at all, they can always come and speak to any member of our team



Student Welfare

Illness Procedures

- If students take any form of medication, please inform us
- Medication can be stored in the management office
- Staff are prohibited from providing any medication to students (including paracetamol)
- If a student is not feeling well, we will take immediate action and bring them to the nearest pharmacy or health centre
- Private medical insurance is included in the Premium & Exclusive Programmes
- The student will bear transport to/from a health centre or pharmacy costs
